Some potential capital projects which may be funded through this campaign are a new sign on Hard Road, improvements to parking lot lighting, liturgical banners, and handicap automatic door openers to name but a few. Fr. Paul, with recommendations from Pastoral Council, Finance Council, Art & Environment Committee, Liturgy Committee, and Staff, will be making the final determination on what improvements are chosen.

You may participate in this campaign by making a donation or by purchasing an Anniversary Brick. (The order form is on the back.)

The first option is to donate directly to St Paul's 50th Anniversary Fundraising Campaign. To donate to this fund please make your checks payable to "St Paul's Church" and put "50th Anniversary Campaign" in the memo line. Please note we are not accepting donations for specific items, as we want all the improvements to be from all the donors. You may also donate to the campaign on our web site; please click on the "50th Anniversary Campaign" link.

The second option is to purchase a Memorial Brick. With the purchase of an engraved brick for St. Paul's 50th Anniversary, you can remember or honor special people in your life, or simply list your family name. The bricks will be placed around the flagpole in the front of the building, with an unveiling of the first group purchased planned for June 4, 2017 at the 50th Anniversary Mass.
