






There are just a few days left in 2025 to make a year end contribution to St. Paul's.

Beckett, Sr. Wendy Sr. Wendy's Bible Treasury (Stories & Wisdom Through the Eyes of Great Painters)

Sr. Wendy, a contemplative nun from Norfolk, England is a frequent presenter on art for the BBC and the author of several books. In this book she discuses some of the stories in the Bible, both Old and New Testament and the masterpieces that were inspired by them. The Old Testament describes some of the most dramatic episodes and memorable characters as illustrated by such paintings as Moses and the Burning Bush by Raphael and David and Goliath by Edgar Degas. In the new Testament the focus shifts to Jesus with His compelling parables and miracles, His birth and His suffering. Sr. Wendy reflects on the paintings that illustrate these events such as The Mystic Nativity by Sandro Botticelli, The Good Samaritan by Eugene Delacroix, and The Last Supper by Leonardo da Vinci, giving new insight into familiar territory. Faith Formation Advent Collection

Kindly join the Faith formation programs for their annual Advent collection on Sunday December 14 during the 9:00 a.m. and 10:00 a.m. Masses. This year, the Faith formation programs are collecting food and personal care items for Rochester Hope. Rochester Hope, attached to St Michael's Church, is a food pantry on North Clinton Avenue in the city. Every Saturday, they provide community breakfast served between 9:30 a.m. and 10:30 a.m., and a community lunch served between 11:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. Their food pantry is open to all zip codes to any individuals or families in need. They neither require ID nor any other documents from those they serve. Those they serve go through a small grocery store and take what they need assisted by a volunteer with no limits placed upon them. Rochester Hope feeds over 400+ individuals and families every Saturday. Those in our Confirmation program did their day of service, volunteering at Rochester Hope on Saturday November 22. We are collecting the following items for Rochester Hope for the Advent collection:

Canned meat, peanut butter, canned vegetables, rice, cereal, coffee/tea, personal care items and diapers

The Faith formation students will bring the collected items during the 9:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. Masses on December 14, in a procession at the Offertory. If you have any questions, or need more information, contact Helen or Anselm.
