



### St. Paul's Question of the Week

Question: Dear Editor, what is the meaning of life?

Response: This is the central question to which every human person seeks an answer – at least subconsciously. Thankfully, God has not hidden the answer from us: God made us to know God, love God, serve God and be happy with God forever in heaven. We can succeed at everything else, but if we fail at holiness, we fail at the reason for our existence. If we succeed at holiness, we can have purpose, peace, and love that nothing in this world can take away. Success at holiness is not just success at what you have done but at who you have become.

People have tried to live for a thousand other things, but none of what the world offers ultimately satisfies us. We can find countless examples of those who have an abundance of wealth, intelligence, athletic skill, or artistic prowess, but none of these, in themselves, satisfies the deepest longing of our hearts. Instead, we find ourselves thinking: There must be something more.

Consider again the observation of Pope Benedict XVI: "the world offers you comfort, but you were not made for comfort, you were made for greatness." The world's philosophies focus on making us comfortable, on satisfying ourselves; and this is precisely why they all fail. The human heart is not made to be fulfilled by mere comfort.

As St. Augustine famously said, 'our hearts are restless until they rest in God.' Pope St. John Paul II observed during his homily for the World Youth Day in Rome on August 19, 200, "it is Jesus that you seek when you dream of happiness; he is waiting for you when nothing else you find satisfies you; he is the beauty to which you are so attracted; it is he who provoked you with that thirst for fullness that will not let you settle for compromise; it is he who urges you to shed the masks of life."

# Hambrook, Diane, & Gail Eisenberg <u>A Mother Loss Workbook:</u> Healing Exercises for Daughters

Both authors lost their mothers at an early age, losses which profoundly affected their lives, even into adulthood. In this book, many women, from ages late-teens to mid- 70s, share their experiences. These narratives will stimulate, inspire, and assure the reader that she is not alone. This workbook is designed to let women who have suffered a similar loss tell their own stories of loss, through varied exercises, open-ended questions, writing topics, and activities. No matter how much time has passed since her mother died, every woman, who has suffered the loss of her mother, needs to fully acknowledge and mourn the extent of her loss and then to take charge of her own future, living her own life honorably. 
