



Seeds for the Journey

This weekend the Church celebrates World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly in honor of Saints Joachim and Anne (Feast Day, July 26th), the father and mother of Mary, the mother of Jesus. While there is no mention of Joachim and Anne in scripture, tradition provides us with intriguing insights into their lives. For example, it is said that Joachim, a descendent of the Jewish tribe of Judah, was a wealthy, generous and respected man, while Anne was the daughter of a priest of the tribe of Levi. Both were strongly adherent to their Jewish faith but were stigmatized by their inability to have children after many years of marriage. Out of frustration, Joachim went into the desert for forty days and nights (sound familiar) to fast and pray for God's guidance. Anne, meanwhile, beyond child-bearing age but longing to have a child and for the return of Joachim, prayed to God, "O God of our fathers, bless me and hear my prayer, as you blessed the womb of Sarah, and gave her a son, Isaac."

According to tradition, both Anne and Joachim were simultaneously visited by an Angel who told them that the Lord had heard their prayer and that Anne would conceive a child. The child, named Mary, was immaculately conceived, and would grow to give birth to Jesus, the Son of God. In the Eastern Orthodox tradition, numerous icons have been written depicting the moment Joachim returned from the desert and reunited with Anne, as they revealed to each other the words of the Angel.



Joachim and Anne, the grandparents of Jesus, raised Mary in a loving and faith filled environment, teaching her to trust God in all things. When the time came for God to invite Mary to give birth to, and raise his son, she was prepared and willingly said yes! On a human level, we have Joachim and Anne to thank for that.

We know little about the lives of Joachim and Anne, nor for that matter, of the childhood of Mary. We do not know if they were alive when Jesus was born, and if so, if they held their grandson in their arms. Never-the-less, we hold them in high esteem as patron saints of parents and grandparents. They endured hard-ship and struggles yet remained steadfast in their faith, their love for God, and their love and devotion to one another. We see these same characteristics re-

flected in the life of Mary, the mother of Jesus and devoted wife to Joseph.

This weekend the Church recognizes grandparents and the elderly as models of hope for others, especially for younger generations. Their endurance and faithfulness throughout their lives are living icons of the power of hope in facing challenges and embracing the future, as exemplified in the lives of Jesus' grandparents, Saints Joachim and Anne. To that end, I invite parents and grandparents to join me in praying the following prayer taken from a Novena to Saints Joachim and Anne.

O Holy Mother and Father of the Blessed Virgin Mary, as parents, you guided and nurtured Mary and, under your protection and love, watched her grow in holiness. Come close to us...and help us to parent our children and grandchildren with a gentle heart as you did. Show us how to raise them in faith and bring our families into the Light of Jesus. Remain close to us and help us on our journey to salvation. Amen!

Anxiety, uncertainty, vulnerability--anyone who has made a big decision knows these feelings. As the complexity of our decisions grows, we constantly seek guidance in dealing with life's possibilities. In every act of free will. in every choice we make, we have the opportunity to follow Jesus. That means making the choice for the greater good and rejecting lesser alternatives. The discernment process, first developed by Ignatius of Loyola, involves rationally outlining the pros and the cons of a possibility, imaginatively considering what it would be like to live with the decision, listening to the movements of the heart, and prayerfully seeking the inner freedom to do what is best.
