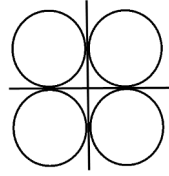

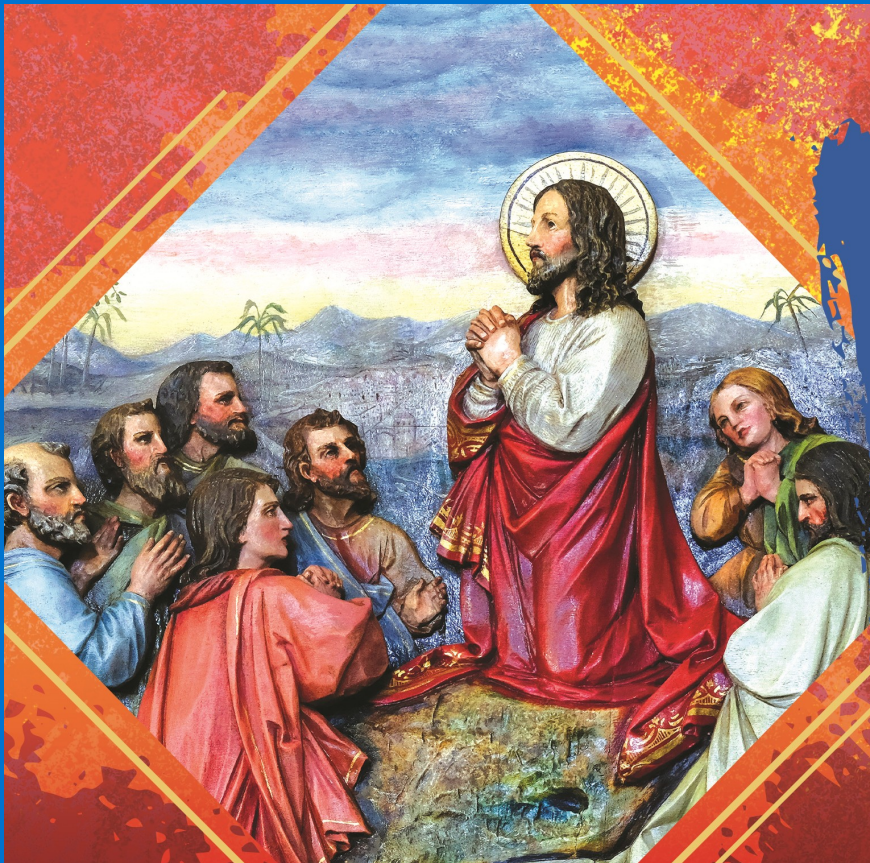

Seeds for the Journey

My name is Elizabeth Robinson, and I have the privilege of serving as the Business Manager in our multi parish finance office. I wanted to take this opportunity to introduce myself and share a little about both my role and my faith journey.

As Business Manager, I work behind the scenes to support several of our parish communities. My responsibilities include overseeing online giving, processing payroll, and managing vendor documentation. While much of my work takes place in an office rather than in the church itself, I am grateful for the opportunity to help support the ministries and mission of our parishes.

What many people may not know is that I did not grow up in a religious family. Faith was not a significant part of my childhood, and if someone had told me years ago that I would one day work for the Catholic Church, I would have found it hard to believe. When I first accepted this position, I did not realize how much it would become part of my life.

As I began working more closely with our parishes, I found myself surrounded by people whose faith was lived out in very real ways. I saw it in the dedication of staff, clergy, and volunteers, and in the way parishioners showed up for their communities. Over time, that example led me to start asking questions and wanting to understand the Catholic faith more deeply.

That curiosity eventually led me to OCIA, the Order of Christian Initiation of Adults. Through OCIA, I began learning more about Scripture, Church teaching, prayer, and the sacraments. More importantly, it gave me space to grow in my understanding of God and begin building a personal relationship with Him.

What started as curiosity slowly became something much deeper. One of the most meaningful moments of that journey came on April 30, when I received the Sacrament of Confirmation from Bishop John S. Bonnici. Standing before the bishop and receiving that sacrament was a moment of deep gratitude and reflection.

Through my work, my interactions with parish communities, and my experience in OCIA, I have come to understand that faith is not about having every answer. It is about being open to God's invitation and trusting where He is leading us.

I am grateful to be part of these parish communities, not only as an employee, but now as a fellow Catholic continuing to grow in faith. Thank you for welcoming me, supporting me, and being part of this journey.
