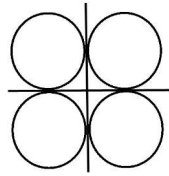

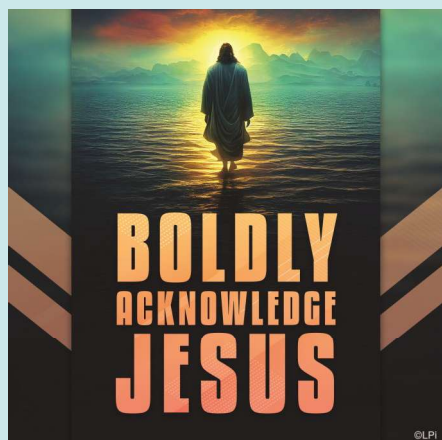

# Seeds for the Journey



It was just an ordinary morning. I was waiting in the Dunkin' Donuts drive-thru, thinking about my long to-do list and what I needed to accomplish that day. When I reached the window to pay, the cashier smiled and handed me my coffee. She told me the driver ahead of me had already paid for it. Then she added, "They said to tell you, 'God bless.'"

I looked ahead, but the car was already gone. I never got to say thank you to that stranger. However, that simple act of kindness stayed with me all day long.

It was a powerful reminder of how God works through people. In a world that often feels rushed and disconnected, that driver chose to share Christ's love with a stranger. They did not want recognition or a favor in return. They simply wanted to brighten someone's day and offer a blessing.

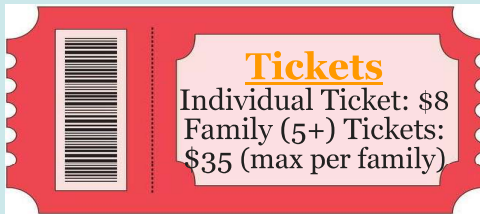

worthy lives.

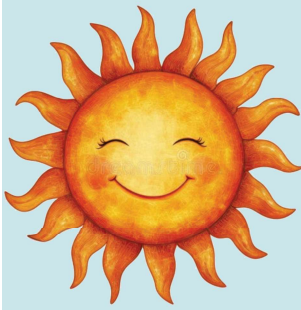
We ask all this in the name of your Son,

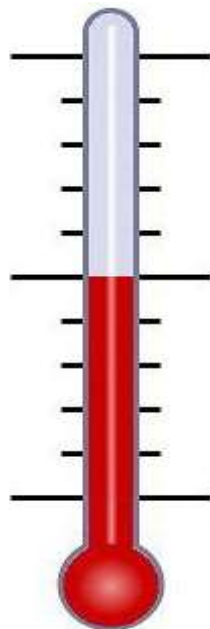

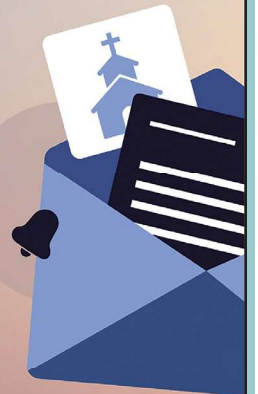
