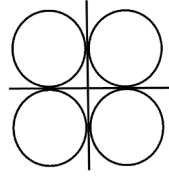

Seeds for the Journey

This weekend we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity. This is a mystery because we can't fully comprehend how we have one God in three Persons: Father, Son and the Holy Spirit. Some people use analogies trying to explain this mystery. For example, St. Patrick used the Shamrock image of three lobes but only one Shamrock. The image of a triangle is also used to demonstrate how there are three sides but only one triangle. These analogies do not really help us understand this mystery of the Holy Trinity.

The most important thing we can learn is that the Holy Trinity forms a perfect relationship of love and unity. We too are called to live in love and unity in our families and the Church. Our church facilities just like our family houses need constant repairs. We need to take care of our building and grounds by contributing money to seal our parking lot and repair the sewer line and concrete sidewalk. The cost of these projects is about \$50,000. Sealing the parking lot = \$16,600 and the project = \$32,192. We are appealing to all parishioners to please be generous in your donations.

Since the Holy Trinity teaches us about love in the family, in the month of June from the 8th, I will be visiting my mama in Kenya. I can't wait to go and stay with her for some weeks now that she is talking, remembering stuff, eating and doing well. It is like a miracle! Thanks for your prayers for her continued healing.

Welcome to St. Paul's Fr. Samuel Mukua Wanyoike

I am Rev. Fr. Samuel Mukua Wanyoike, from the Archdiocese of Nairobi, Kenya. I am the firstborn son of the late Teresia Wanjeri, and I come from a close-knit family alongside my siblings, Bernard Wanyoike Mukua and John Karechu Mukua.

I was ordained to the priesthood in 25th July, 1998 and have since dedicated my life to pastoral ministry and service to the Church and society. Over the years, I have served in various parishes and missions, beginning at Kiriko Catholic Mission (1999-2001), followed by Ting'ang'a Catholic Parish (2001-2005), and later at Holy Family Minor Basilica (2005-2007). I continued my missionary work at Liok Catholic Mission (2007-2021) and Mutomo Catholic Mission (2012-2023). Currently, I serve as the Pastor of St. Teresa of Avila Catholic Parish, Eastleigh.

In addition to my pastoral work, I have a strong academic and professional background. I hold a Master of Arts in Social Ministry with a specialization in Governance, which has greatly enriched my approach to leadership and community development.

Beyond parish ministry, I have been actively involved in education and social initiative. I served as a teacher at St. Anne's Secondary School in Lioki from 2007 to 2012. I am also the founder of several educational and charitable institutions, including St. Gabriel Mixed Day and Boarding Primary School in Mutomo, St Joseph the Worker mixed Primary and Secondary School in Ting'ang'a, and St. Simon's Nursery and Feeding Center in Kilooma. Additionally, I founded Care and Share organization, a non-governmental organization committed to supporting vulnerable members of society.

Through these experiences, I have remained committed to holistic ministry-nurturing both the spiritual and social well-being of the communities I serve.

In my free time, I enjoy playing golf, which provides me with relaxation and an opportunity for reflection.

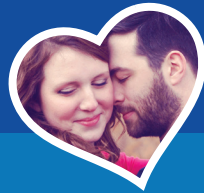

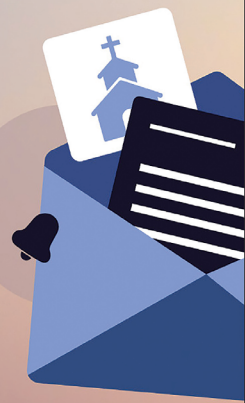
