



Make a Gift to the CMA from Your IRA A Special Opportunity if 70-1/2 or Older

You can give any amount (up to \$105,000 per year) from your IRA directly to the CMA without having to pay taxes on the amount given as a part of your annual income. Gifts of any value less that \$105,000 or less are eligible for this benefit and you are making a difference for the Diocese of Rochester and your parish. This popular gift option is commonly called the **charitable IRA rollover**, but you may also see it referred to as a **qualified charitable distribution (QCD).** Your disbursement must come directly from the administrator of your IRA to the Diocese you should not receive the funds first.

Bourgeault, Cynthia The Meaning of Mary Magdalene (Discovering the Woman at the Heart of Christianity)

If you look in the Bible, ether are only a handful of verses that speak of Mary Magdalene and yet she is one of the most influential symbols of Christianity. The author, and Episcopalian priest and author of several books, hopes to repair the damage cause by the patriarchal and sometimes misogynist tradition and reclaim Mary Magdalene's legitimate role as a teacher and disciple. Reverend Bourgeault examines the Bible, church tradition, art, and legend. What emerges is a radical view of Mary Magdalene as one of Jesus' most important disciples, perhaps the one who best understood His teachings. She was a person for whom Jesus had a deep spiritual love; she was present at crucifixion and was one of the first witnesses to the resurrection. Reverend Bourgeault carefully reexamines the role played by the woman we through we know. (Call No. 226.092-Bou)
