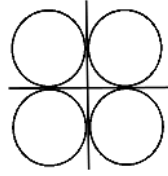

Seeds for the Journey

November Although some dread this month because of its shorter days, and the promise of grey skies, cold winds and snow, we might want to welcome it for other reasons. Of course, November anticipates Thanksgiving, the time when we reflect on our blessings, and gather with family and friends to enjoy food, football, and shopping frenzy. But as a Catholic Christian, it is *this* weekend that signifies our connectedness as human beings, and the recognition of the spiritual bond that exists between the living and the departed, the communion of saints. We celebrate All Saints' Day on November 1 and All Souls Day on November 2 "to remind us that death is not the end, but rather the door through which we must pass to gain eternal life." (U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops)

November 1, All Saints' Day, is a feast that commemorates the holy women and men who are in heaven. While "saint" is an official title given to those "whose lives the church has thoroughly investigated (typically through whose intercession two legitimate miracles can be proven to have occurred), the term applies to anyone in heaven. The saints are our friends, our intercessors, our brothers and sisters in Christ. To commemorate the saintly lives of those who've gone before us, we solemnly celebrate by attending Mass.

November 2, All Souls' Day, is a time when we pause to remember all those who have died. This special day isn't just about sadness for our losses, but instead is a chance to reflect, pray and celebrate their lives. All Souls' Day focuses on those souls who are still on their spiritual journey toward God. Catholics believe in the power of prayer, charity and the Mass to help souls on their journey to eternal life. This day reminds us that death doesn't break the bonds of love – we can still care for those who've gone before us.

Come pray with us...Mass of Remembrance, November 2 at the 11 am Mass. We will especially remember those whose funerals were celebrated this year at St. Paul's as well as our loved ones who've passed on.

St. Paul's Parish is blessed with ministries and opportunities that provide spiritual support, guidance and comfort to those who have experienced the death of a loved one, as well as to those preparing for death. We are connected to one another through our faith and our life experiences. Our hope is that as part of our parish family, you will feel comfortable reaching out when in need and volunteering when inspired.

If you have a desire to help...

The **Funeral Ministry Team** consists of persons who assist with funerals as Greeters, Ushers, Sacristans, and Acolytes. Please consider this spiritually rewarding way to serve fellow parishioners during a difficult time. The many thank-you notes that arrive following the funerals attest to the compassion and kindness of the volunteers of this ministry.

The **Marthas** is a Hospitality Ministry that provides a warm and welcoming environment where grieving families can meet with relatives and friends following a funeral service.

If you are grieving the loss of a loved one...

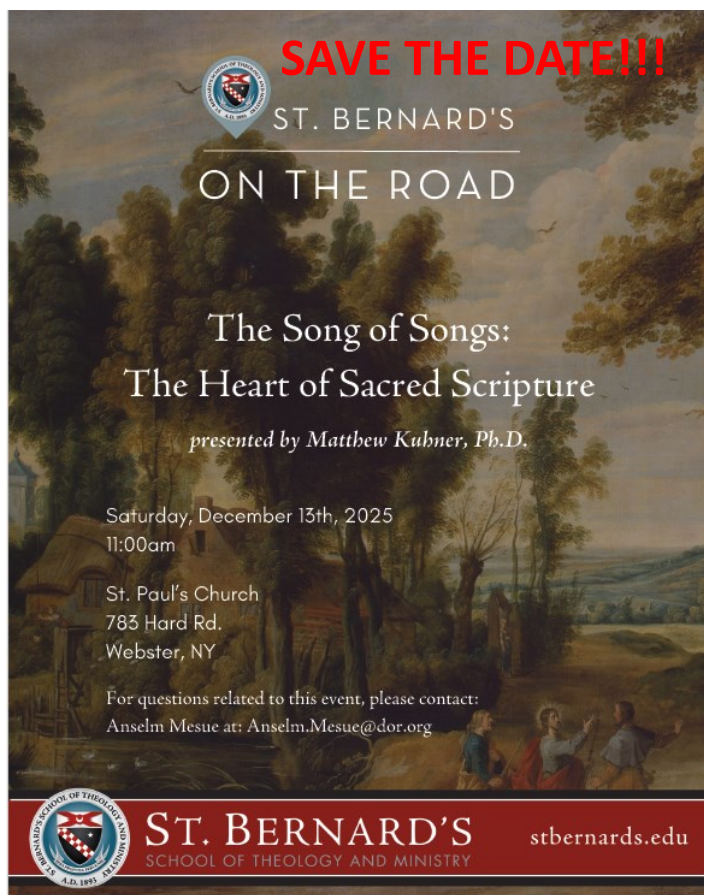
Together in Grief is a bereavement program that offers support and friendship to people grieving the death of a loved one. Those who attend the monthly gatherings accompany one another through listening, sharing stories, enjoying refreshments and praying together. Each member pledges confidentiality and respect. **Meetings are held on the 3rd Thursday of the month at 11:00am, from September through June.**

If you would like to pre-plan your funeral ...

Advance Funeral Planning is a simple act that allows a person to plan a funeral prior to death. The information on our parish website along with the guidance of the funeral planner, allows you to choose scriptural readings and hymns, and lets your family know your wishes for your funeral liturgy. This will give peace of mind to you and your family since there will be less difficult decisions to make at a time of emotional hardship.

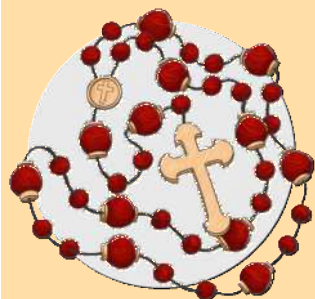

Second Collection:

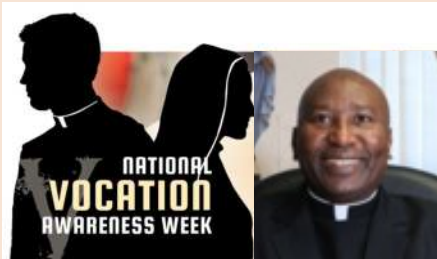
Archdiocese for the Military Services
