

# Seeds for the gourney

## **November 2022 Building & Staff Update**

As noted in a previous Seeds article some major repairs were planned for the summer. Some happened, some didn't, and some others popped up and surprised us. Here is a recap:

A roof drain was installed to finally mitigate the persistent leak in the northeast ceiling panel. It appears to have solved the issue as no further water damage has been observed. Ben will repair and paint the ceiling panel for what we hope will be the last time!

Cracked tile in the church main aisle and worn carpet outside the music room was replaced with vinyl tile. Next on the list for new vinyl is the sacristy which still has the original linoleum and carpet from 1967.

Cracked windows in the boiler room were replaced with glass block.

The broken AC unit in the music room was replaced. Of course, within several weeks the identical unit in the Narthex stopped working. Fortunately, the heat still operates in this unit so we are OK with this until next year.

Parking lot sealing which was planned for this summer has been postponed to next summer due to lack of availability of materials (sealer and striping paint.)

Concrete sidewalk work has also been postponed.

The boilers have also required several unexpected repairs. As they are the primary source of heat for much of the building, these repairs are required.

Ben continues to manage the regular day to day maintenance for the buildings. Unexpected things will occur; that is common with a 50+ year old church and rectory.

In other excellent news, John has agreed to be our Music Coordinator! We are grateful to him for his support during the staffing transition. He has revived our choir and brought joy back to our music program. We are also blessed with our additional organists Judy and Malgorzata who assist John by playing at some of the Masses.

A reminder that in addition to weekend Masses, daily Mass is at 8:30 AM Monday -Thursday.

The parish office is open Monday-Friday from 8:30 AM to noon and 1:00 to 4:30 PM. The building is locked (for security) so please ring the bell (at the Hard Road door entrance) and we will buzz you in.

## **November/December Envelopes**



# Barron, Bishop Robert <u>Vibrant Paradoxes</u> (The Both / And of Catholicism)

The Church often celebrates the union of seeming opposites: grace and nature, Scripture and tradition, body and soul. Each opposing element retains its full energy and truth. After all, Jesus was both fully divine and fully human, each nature non-competitively present to the other in the unity of his person. This book is divided into five pairs of these apparent opposites: "Sin and Mercy," "Reason and Faith," "Matter and Spirit," "Freedom and Discipline," "Suffering and Joy." Some people live in an "either / or" universe in which a person can have one of the elements but not both. Sadly, our world is torn apart by antagonism, even hatred, toward opposite points of view.
