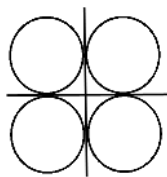

IT'S CM-YAY TIME

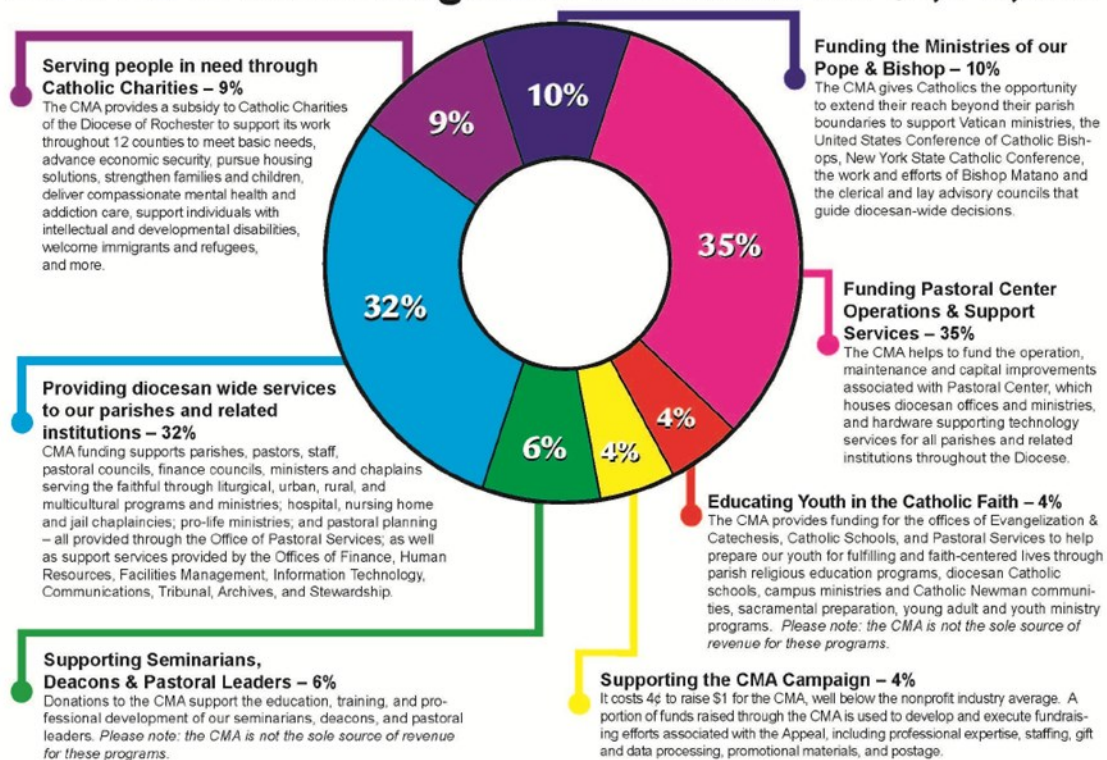
Here we are again.... That wonderful time of year. The mornings are crisp, the leaves are beautiful colors, and school is back in session. Whether you are a Pumpkin Spice or Apple Crisp lover, (for me apple all the way) this season always brings Buffalo Bills stress and the CMA kick off. This year the Bishop has asked St. Paul's to raise \$108,000 for the CMA.

The #1 most asked question I've had in my almost 15 years working for the Diocese is....1. Where does my money go????????? Please know all monies raised in the CMA are only used for the programs, services and ministries outlined below. No gifts to the CMA are used to satisfy settlement costs associated with abuse.

In the coming weeks and months, you will hear from Fr. Paul, myself and members of our Finance Council encouraging you to consider giving to the CMA. You can give Online, or with one of the CMA envelopes located at each entrance to church (please feel free to drop that envelope right in the collection basket and we will make sure it gets to the CMA office).

Last year over 261 families donated to either the CMA directly or the parish CMA shortfall. If you haven't given please consider a donation this year... If you have given please know how much we appreciate your donation and ask if you have the ability to give even \$10 more this year.

Desires of the Heart

This book of 48 prayer experiences helps readers develop their relationship with God and become aware of the many ways we encounter God in our daily lives. Each session is really a mini-retreat, offering prayers, scripture readings, reflections, space for journaling, and song lyrics. 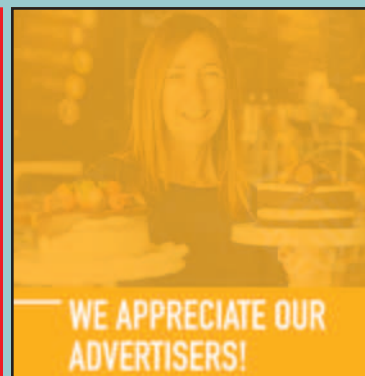
