Mary Gordon writes about one woman's relationship with her blind neighbor; Barry Lopez describes one young man's attempt to redeem himself after one violent mistake; Joyce Carol Oates creates a haunting confrontation between Norma Jean (Marilyn Monroe) and a godlike photographer; John Barth meditates on the diminishment of life brought by age and change.
